1. CALL OF MEETING TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Village of Eden Board was called to order by President Kevin Goebel

Roll Call was taken.

A motion was made by Jay Baumhardt and seconded by Joe Preston to approve the minutes from March 19, 2024, monthly board meeting, as presented. Motion Carried. Unanimously.

A motion was made by Joe Preston and seconded by Shea Stahl to approve the treasurer's report, as presented. Motion Carried. Unanimously.

With Guelig's waste removal so close, the board didn't think it was necessary. We will also get pamphlets from Harter's to include, with sewer bills, different ways to dispose of bulky waste.

There was a discussion about giving Ken Abhold credit on sewer bills due to remodeling the apartment he owns. The board didn't think this was a good idea, since there were other people who did not receive credit during their projects.

There was a discussion on offering food truck service in the Village. There were concerns about taking business away from the Bar and Restaurants within the Village. The board is going to reach out to those establishments and get their feedback. This discussion was tabled until the next monthly meeting.
