

ORDINANCE DESIGNATING STREETS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF EDEN LIMITS AS ALL TERRAIN VEHICLE ROUTES AND REGULATING THE OPERATION OF SUCH VEHICLES ON THESE STREETS.

The Village Board of the Village of Eden do ordain as follows:

Section I: Intent.

The Village Board of the Village of Eden, Fond du Lac County, Wisconsin, adopts the following ordinance permitting all-terrain vehicles (ATV) to be operated upon the roadways listed in Section II for access to the Eisenbaum Trail, pursuant to the authority granted the Village under §23.33(8) and (11), Wisconsin Statutes.

Section II: Routes.

The following streets within the Village limits are designated all-terrain vehicle routes to the Eisenbaum Trail during the periods of time that the Eisenbaum Trail is open for ATV use:

- A. Elizabeth Street
- B. Church Street
- C. Center Street
- D. Elm Street
- E. Sheridan Street
- F. Grahl Avenue
- G. Sherman Street
- H. Pine Street
- I. Martin Avenue
- J. Margaret Avenue
- K. Southgate Drive
- L. Parkview Drive
- M. David Court
- N. Carolyn Court
- O. JP Court
- P. Seybold Drive
- Q. Mark Court
- R. Reagan Drive
- S. Ernest Court

Section III: Conditions.

The use of the above streets as all-terrain vehicle routes is subject to the following conditions:

- A. The ATV operator shall observe a speed limit of 15 miles per hour.
- B. The ATV shall be registered according to Wisconsin State Statutes.
- C. All ATV operation shall be conducted in accordance with §23.33(4)(d), Wis. Stats.
- D. There will be two areas to cross St Rd 45:
  - 1. The intersection of Elizabeth Street and St Rd 45

2. The intersection of Grahl Avenue and St Rd 45

Section IV: Enforcement.

This ordinance shall be enforced by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

Section V: Signage.

Appropriate signage will be displayed on all streets that are involved in this ordinance.

Section VI: Penalties.

The penalty provision found in §23.33(13)(a) Wis. Stats., is adopted herein by reference.

Section VII: Severability.

If any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance or any underlying statute or administrative code section adopted by reference herein is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall not be affected.

Section VIII: Effective Date.

This ordinance becomes effective upon passage and publication.
