Garbage and Recyclables

Garbage pick-up is every Friday and recyclables are picked up every other Friday. Only exception is some holiday weeks. The village clerk can provide you with the yearly calendar of pick up dates. If you do not have a calendar, please ask for one. Containers are provided by the village. If your container gets damaged, please contact the village office at 920-477-4304. Containers on the day of pick up must be placed at the end of your driveway and made assessable for the garbage truck to pick up by 6:00 AM. Please leave at least 3 feet between garbage and recycling container

Snow Removal

From November 1st to April 1st, There is NO Overnight Parking on village streets. Sidewalks must be cleared by noon the following day of snowfall. Please make sure sidewalks are kept clear of snow, ice and debris. Do Not Blow or Shovel snow back into a cleared street.

Grass Clippings and Yard Waste

Do not blow grass clippings into the street. There is a dumpster located at the Village Park for grass clippings and yard waste.

Property Taxes

Property taxes bills are mailed out by the 15th of December of each year.

Payment in full or 1st installment is due by January 31st to the Village of Eden office located in the Eden Community Center –104 Pine Street , (PO Box 65). Collection dates and times will be included in your tax bill. After January 31st, all payments are collected at the Fond Du Lac County Treasures Office (County Government Office) 160 S. Macy Street in Fond Du Lac. 2nd installment is due by July 31st and payment to Fond Du Lac County.

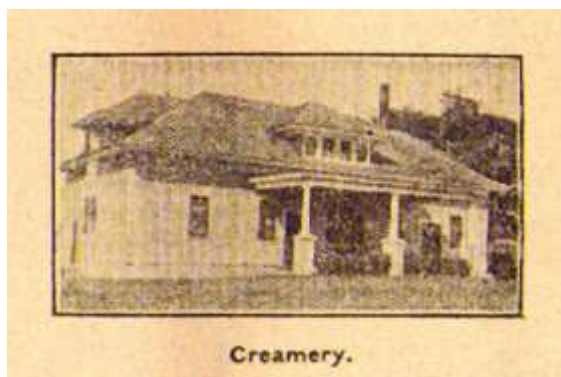

That Eden lies in the center of one of the most productive agricultural sections in this part of the state is well known by all who are acquainted with the country. The section developed rapidly, especially in the past several years, and the progressive farmers grew in number. These conditions meant a greater future for the village. For years Eden realized that a banking institution was one of the business enterprises it was greatly in need of and after some united activity a bank was launched.



The Eden State Bank was organized in 1910 with a capital stock of \$15,000. A modern two story brick structure with a handsome stone front was erected in the center of the business part of the village. The lower floor of the building is used for the banking business, which consists of general banking, insurance and conveyances. The upper floor is used for offices while the basement is the home of a restaurant, being well fitted for that purpose. The cost of the building and bank fixtures was in the neighborhood of \$10,000. The officers of the bank are President, Wm. Nast Sr.; vice president Martin Kaeding; cashier W. J. Nast. These with the following gentlemen comprise the board of directors: George Flood, H. A. Kaeding and George W. Nast. As was predicted the bank has enjoyed a good business ever since its organization and is growing rapidly. The deposits are \$143,000.

The Village of Eden is located within the Town of Eden in Fond du Lac County. At the time of the 2010 census, the population was 875. The population in 2018 was estimated at 892.

While the village was founded c. 1882, a post office called Eden was first established in 1850.

The village is named after either the Garden of Eden or John Eden, an early settler.
