

ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REMOVAL OF ICE AND SNOW ON  
SIDEWALKS

The Village Board of the Village of Eden, Fond du Lac County, Wisconsin, do  
ordain as follows:

SECTION 1:

The owner or occupant, or person in charge of every lot, or part of lot shall,  
before 12:00 o'clock noon of each day shall remove all snow and ice which may have  
fallen or accumulated upon the sidewalk in front of the premises owned occupied, or  
cared for by him. When ice is so formed upon any sidewalk that it cannot be removed,  
such person shall keep the same sprinkled with sand and/or salt in such a way and manner  
as to prevent the same from being dangerous for pedestrian travel.


SECTION 2:

The Village Board shall cause all sidewalks which have not been cleaned or  
sprinkled with sand or salt to be cleaned or sprinkled in its discretion immediately upon  
the default of any person whose duty it shall be to clean said sidewalks. The Village shall  
keep an accurate account of the expenses of removing snow and ice from sidewalks or  
sprinkling the same and the same shall be reported to the Village Clerk. The Village  
Clerk shall make a report to the Village Board and cause the amount of such expense to  
be inserted in the tax roll against the property to which chargeable and the same shall be  
collected in the same time and manner as other special assessment taxes upon real estate.
